## General information:

$\Rightarrow$ EMS and Fire Personnel are assigned to a station to serve as Judges.
$\Rightarrow$ Checklists/grading sheets are provided at each station.
$\Rightarrow$ Patrols must send 1-2 Scouts to a 911 station to report their situation and provide information on care being provided.
$\Rightarrow$ Selected stations will also have optional BONUS questions on selected Scout skills (map reading, ceremonies, etc.).
$\Rightarrow$ Scout leaders or other adults ARE NOT allowed to assist, travel with, or observe their Scouts during competition.
$\Rightarrow$ One WEBLEOS leader or adult MAY travel with the WEBELOS scouts but are prohibited from assisting the Scouts during competition.
$\Rightarrow$ JUDGES are encouraged to provide general feedback and answer questions if time remains before each rotation is called.
$\Rightarrow$ ALL Judges will be asked to meet with the Scouts at the conclusion of each round to provide feedback and answer questions.

NOTE: In prior years, we have been fortunate enough to have Scouts become EMT's and volunteer firefighters based on their experiences at the First Aid meet and their interaction with the judges!

## General Scout Information:

1. Patrol Size: Min. 4, Max 6
2. Each station will be 10 minutes in duration.
3. Each Patrol must have its own patrol fir st aid kit (no sharing). Scout handbooks and/or first aid books are not allowed.
4. Patrols DO NOT leave a station until given the signal to rotate
5. Registration deadline for Scouts: Sat., March 4.
6. WEBELOS \& Cub Scouts are scored according to their ability and training.
